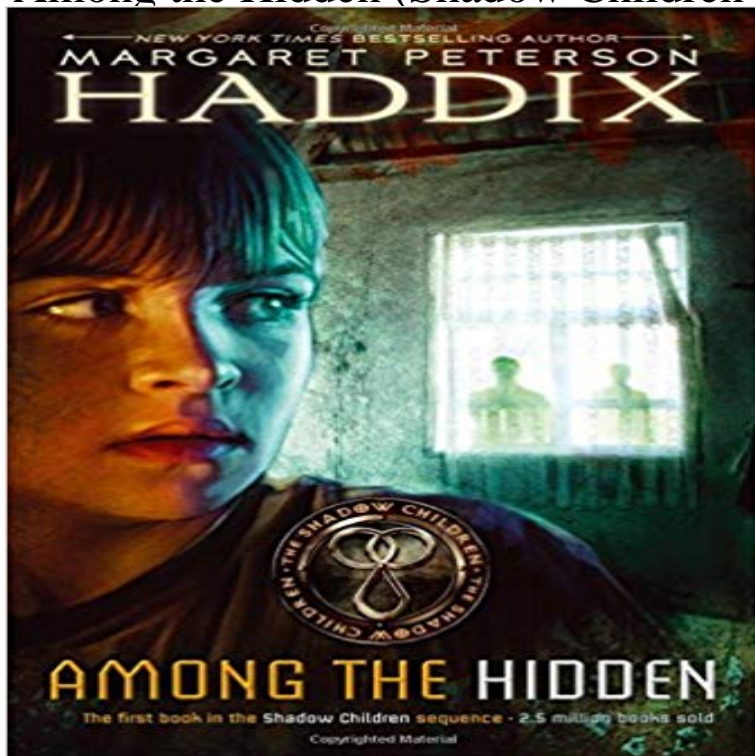


Among the Hidden (Shadow Children #1)
