


In Defiance of Reason: The Failure of Modern Economics and the Coming Dark Age



The Industrialized nations of the world are presently faced with the common issues of excessive sovereign debt, stagnant economies, aging demographics, and rising youth unemployment. Given the spread of this common economic malaise, it should come as no surprise that these problems arise from a common cause. In *Defiance of Reason* tackles the economic problem with a comprehensive rational examination of the past Century, exposing the myths of Monetarism and revealing the true nature of the Economic Crisis. Economics is the study of Human Civilization, and just as great civilizations are built through the labors of many successive generations, the decline and fall of such civilizations rarely happens all at once. The decline of a given nation, however, can often be traced back to a single event, though often one whose significance was not recognized by contemporary statesmen and scholars. In the West, the event in question was the advent of Central Banking, which though it was touted as a new and powerful tool of Democracy by Keynes and other leading figures of the early 20th Century, ultimately served only to corrupt and destroy the function of free markets which had given Western Democracies the political power and productive capacities which they then enjoyed. No market has been truly free since the founding of the Federal Reserve in 1913. The present debates which dominate political circles merely serve to distract public attention from the true cause of their distress, and abstract from public understanding the true system of political economy in which they live. It is not Capitalism, but Corporatism, not progression to new ideas of freedom, but regression under the tyranny of particular mercantile interests. All of the policy mistakes and economic misconceptions which Adam Smith worked so hard to rectify with *Wealth of Nations*, have been reborn as a result of Keynes

General Theory. In *Defiance of Reason* is divided into four parts. The first part examines the state of empirical science, and the study of statistics in particular, to expose how it is that the science of economics came to be so profoundly corrupted. Part II examines the macroeconomic consequences which arise from the incorrect understanding of economics, and of the twin concepts of money and capital in particular. The third section examines the microeconomic impact of public misdirection of capital. The manner in which value is measured affects virtually every decision made in business, and as such any inaccuracy in measurement or method can have dire consequences for both workers and businesses. The final part attempts to describe the general character of Western Democracies, underlining the founding principles of the United States in particular.

It was liberty which allowed Democracy to become so powerful and prosperous, and it was the subversion of liberty, and the usurpation of individual economic freedoms which are now threatening to bring about the ruin of Western Nations. Readers will be astonished to discover how long it took to craft the Crisis we find ourselves in at present, and troubled by how far the damage to our freedom and prosperity have been allowed to progress. Much of that damage is no longer reparable in the near term. However, if any solution is to ever be found, the true nature of the problem at hand must first be fully and firmly understood.
