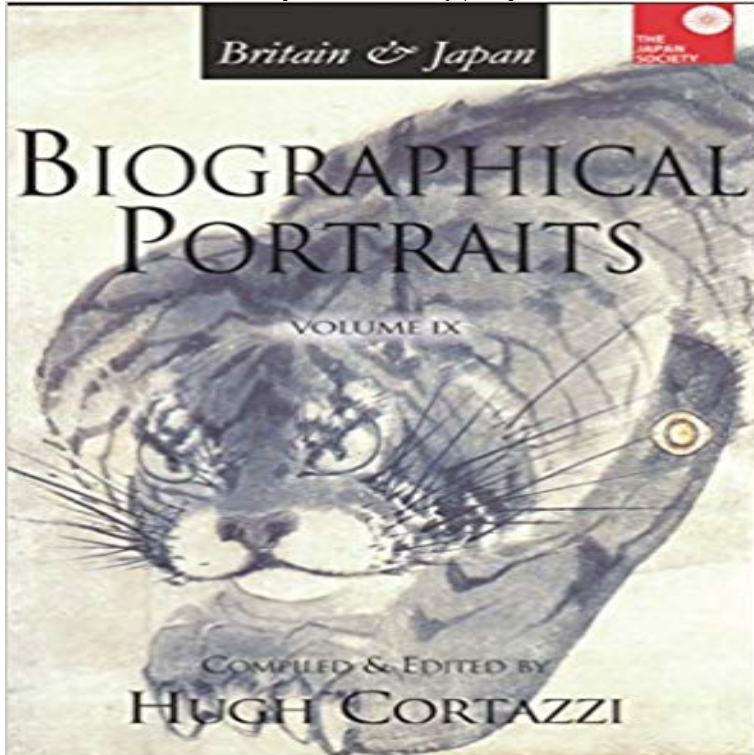


Britain and Japan: Biographical Portraits, Vol. IX: 9 (Britain & Japan)
