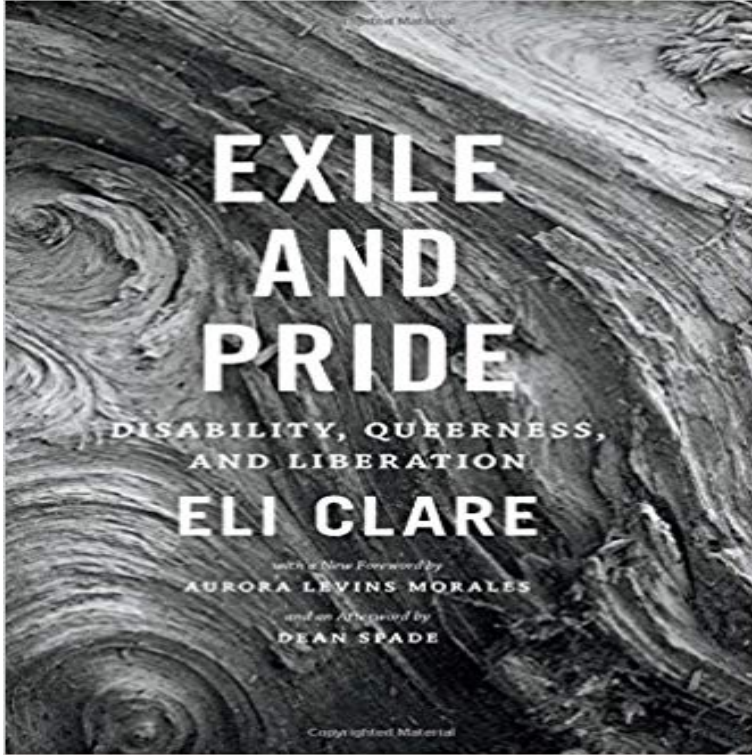


# Exile and Pride: Disability, Queerness, and Liberation
