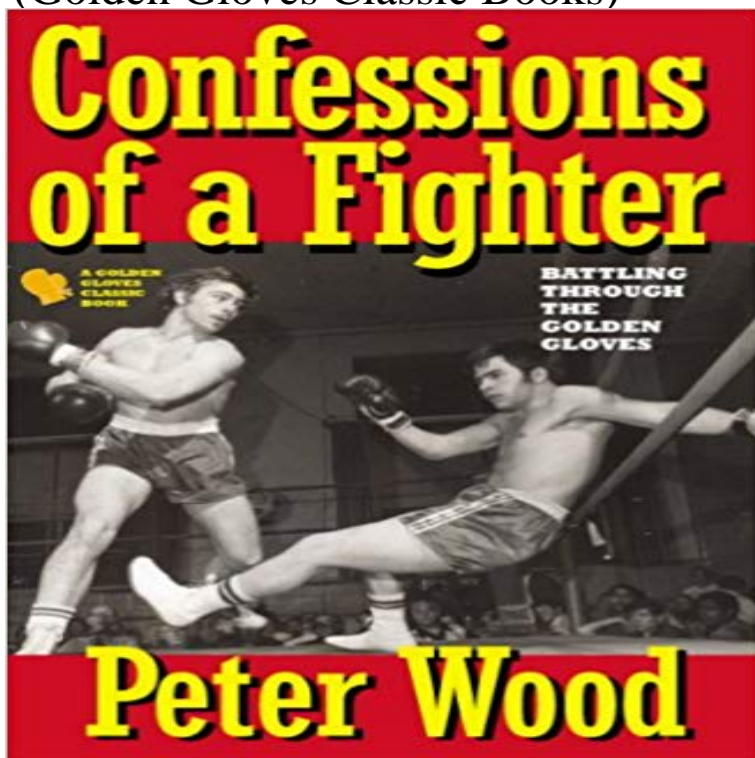


# Confessions of a Fighter: Battling Through the New York Golden Gloves (Golden Gloves Classic Books)
