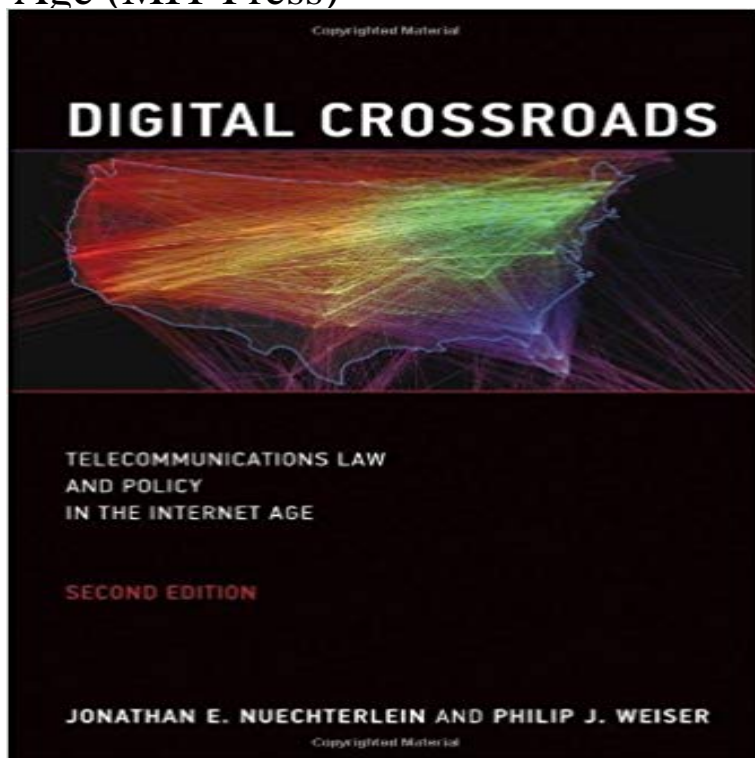


# Digital Crossroads: Telecommunications Law and Policy in the Internet Age (MIT Press)
