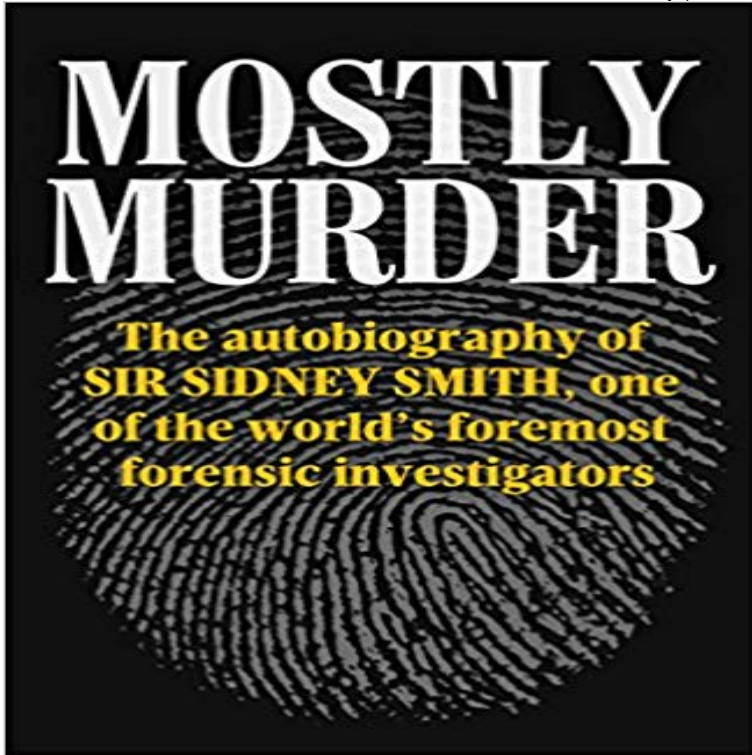


# Mostly Murder: The Autobiography of Sir Sidney Smith, One of the Worlds Foremost Forensic Investigators

Smith, a real life Sherlock Holmes, solved crimes using a variety of field and laboratory techniques such as ballistic analysis, some of which he pioneered. Included is a Foreword by legendary crime novelist Erle Stanley Gardner, and 23 pages of illustrations from the original book [note that several of the illustrations are graphic in nature and not suitable for younger readers].
