


Sexual Fantasy Handbook, Volume 1: How to Cope with Forbidden Sexual Desires and Unexpected Sexual Situations



This book presents a series of short stories and articles that explore and explain human sexual behavior. The goal of the series is to help people better understand their sexual desires and make better decisions how to respond to them, by considering the possible results of alternative courses of action. The focus of the series is on a woman's response to repressed sexual desires and unexpected sexual situations, and the narrative viewpoint is often that of a woman. Each story of the series is self-contained, and unrelated to others in the series. The stories are intended to serve as case studies, or scenarios, for consideration and discussion, to help people decide what is best for them. In some situations, graphic but realistic coarse language is used. The goal is to be sexually explicit, not to be gratuitously pornographic or prurient. It is simply an accurate reflection of the language used by many people in particular intimate situations. Just as in the case of the recent (2013) film, *The Wolf of Wall Street*, the language is authentically reflective of today's culture. Most romantic novels, and many erotic pieces, avoid the use of coarse language. This is done to promote readership (mommy porn), but at great cost to realism and loss of emotional content. Words have the power to arouse, stimulate and shock. Coarse language is an essential emotional component of many sexual encounters, both within marriage and without. Each article is published separately, and a collection of them is published as a single set under the title, *Sexual Fantasies Handbook: How to Cope with Forbidden Sexual Desires and Unexpected Sexual Situations*.
