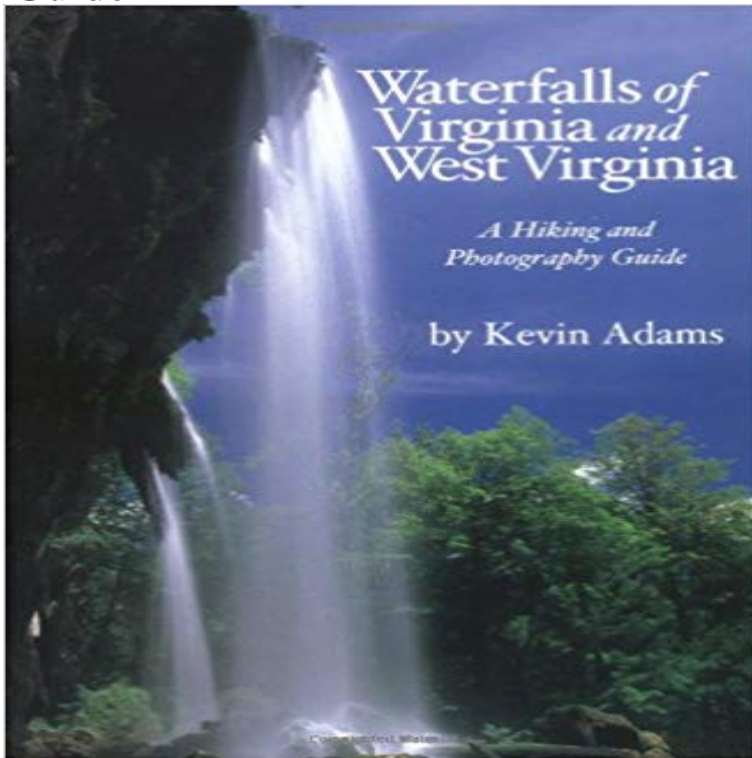


# Waterfalls of Virginia and West Virginia: A Hiking and Photography Guide
