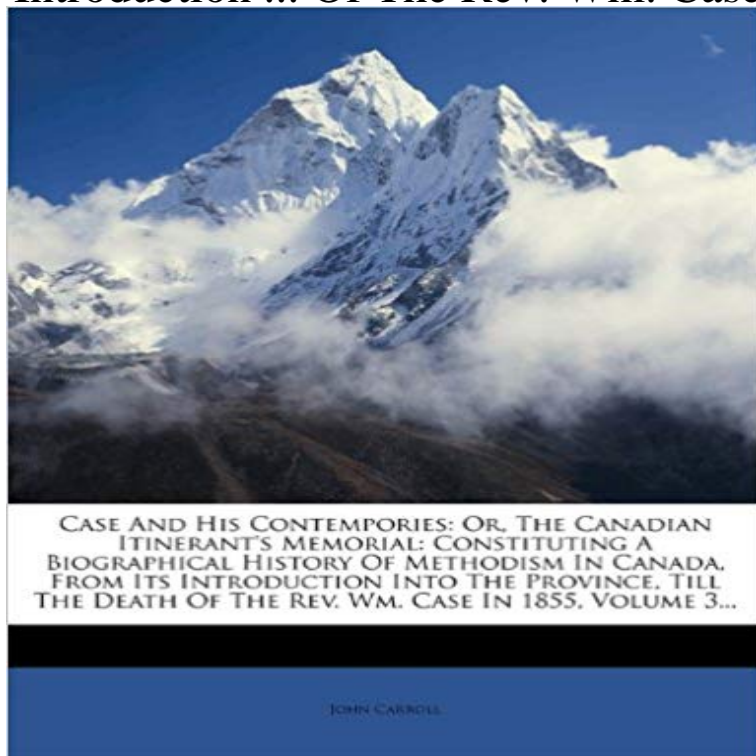

His family moved to Edwardsburgh, Upper Canada, shortly after the War of 1812. Jackson was given his deacons orders in 1818, at the Genesee conference. At its peak the church had 7000 members.
