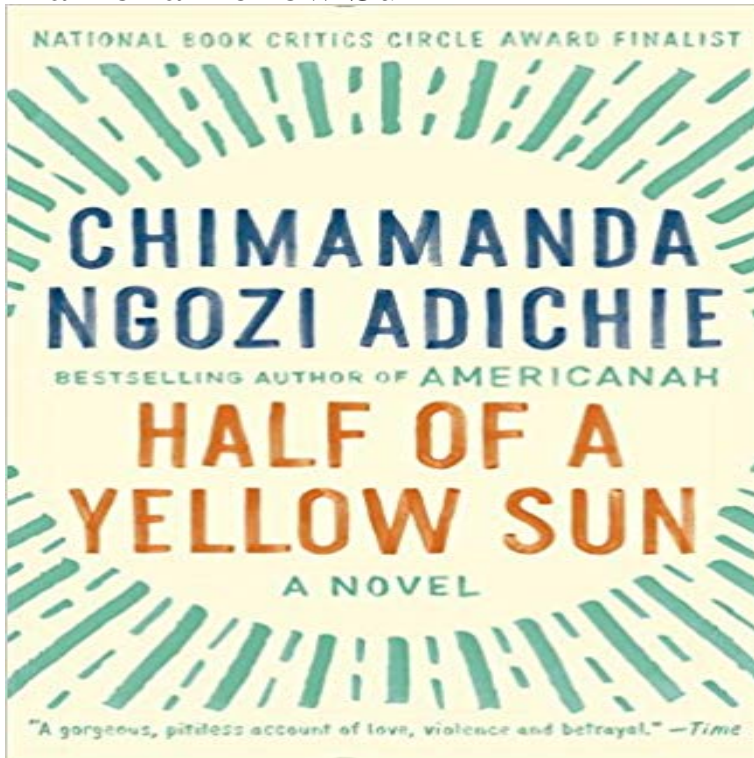


Half of a Yellow Sun
