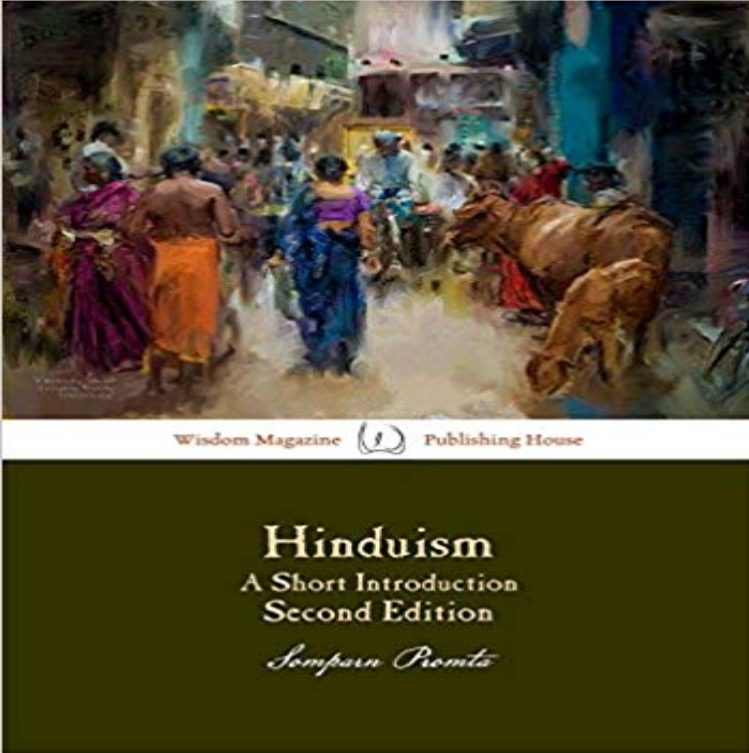


# Hinduism: A Short Introduction
