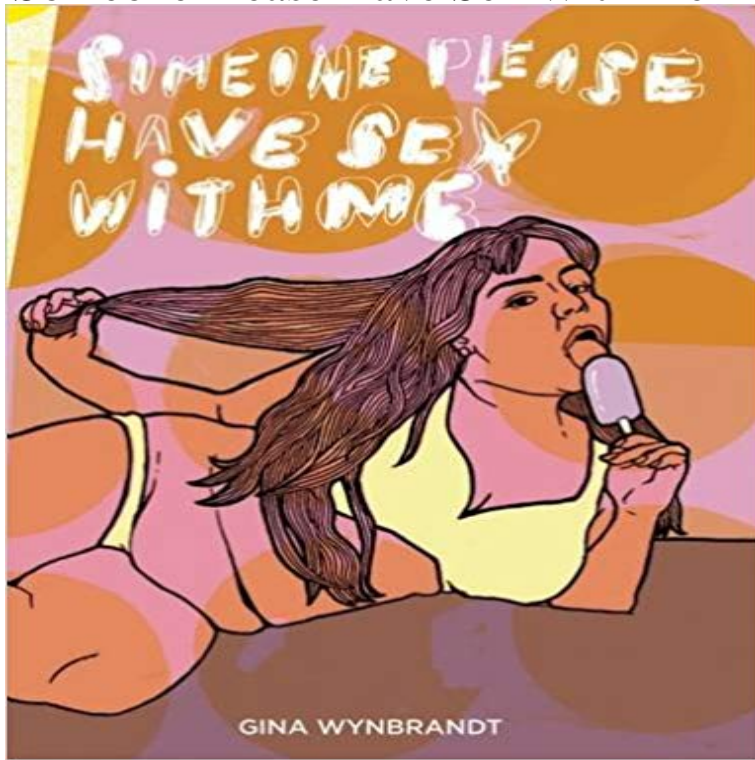


Someone Please Have Sex With Me
