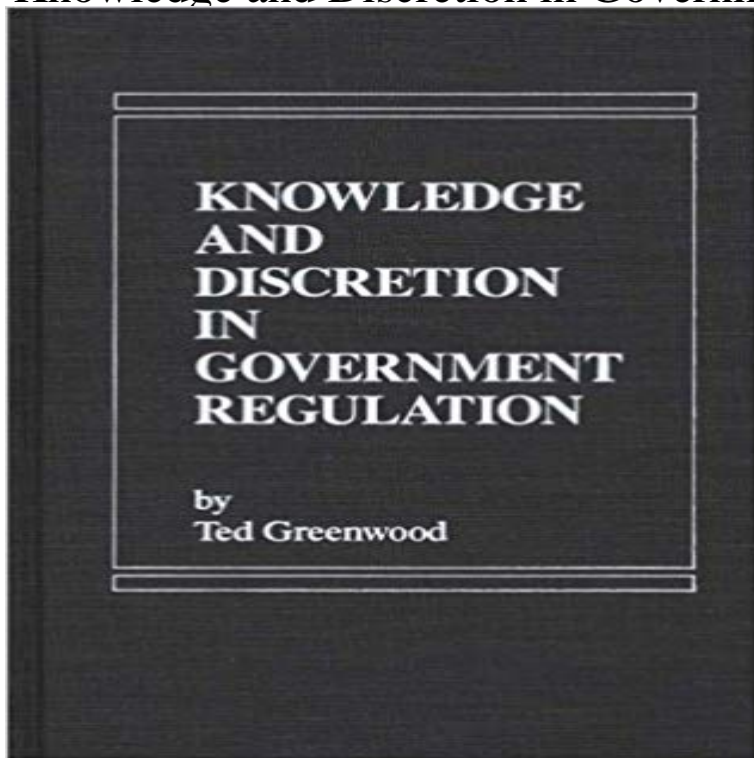


Knowledge and Discretion in Government Regulation
