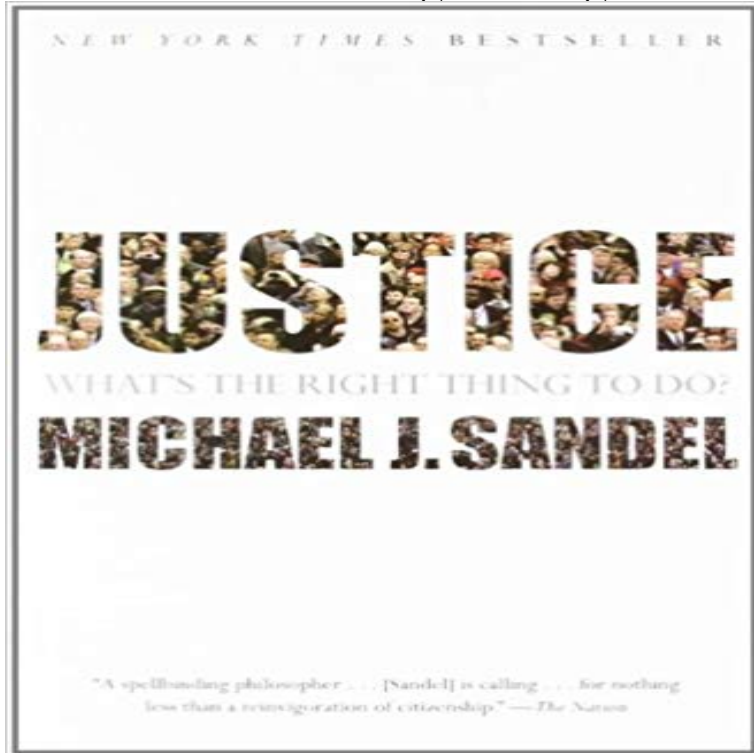


Justice: Whats the Right Thing to Do?
