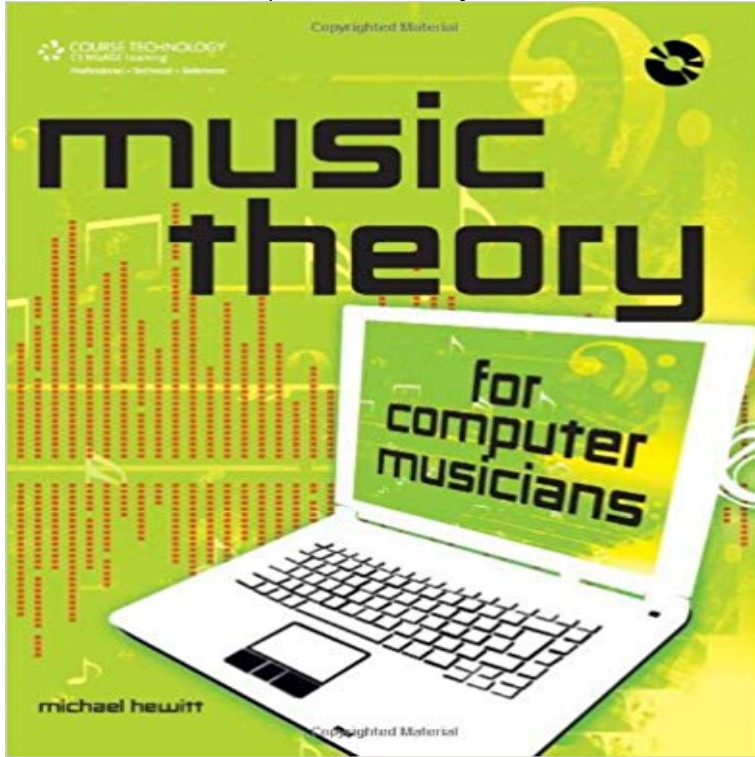


Music Theory for Computer Musicians
