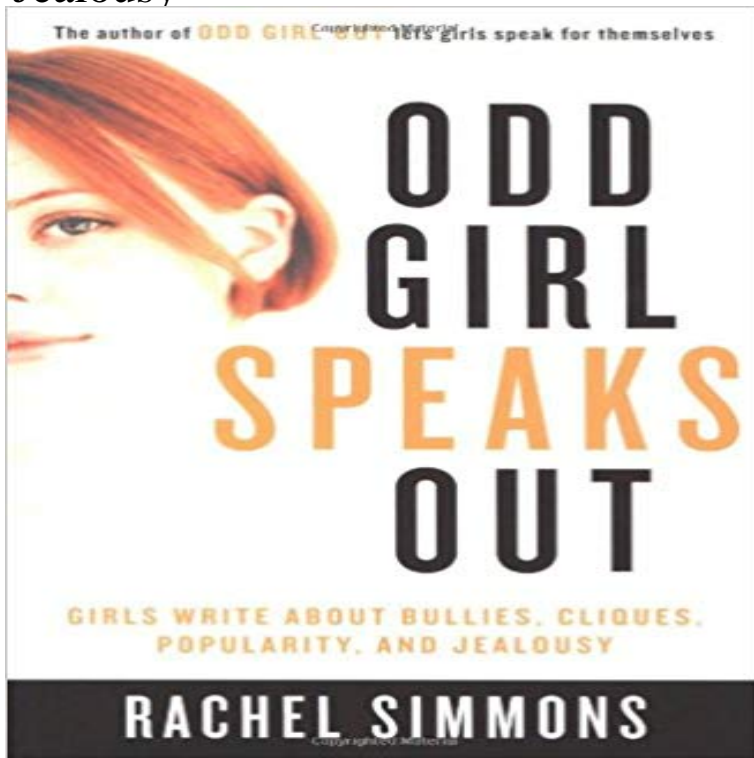


Odd Girl Speaks Out: Girls Write about Bullies, Cliques, Popularity, and Jealousy
