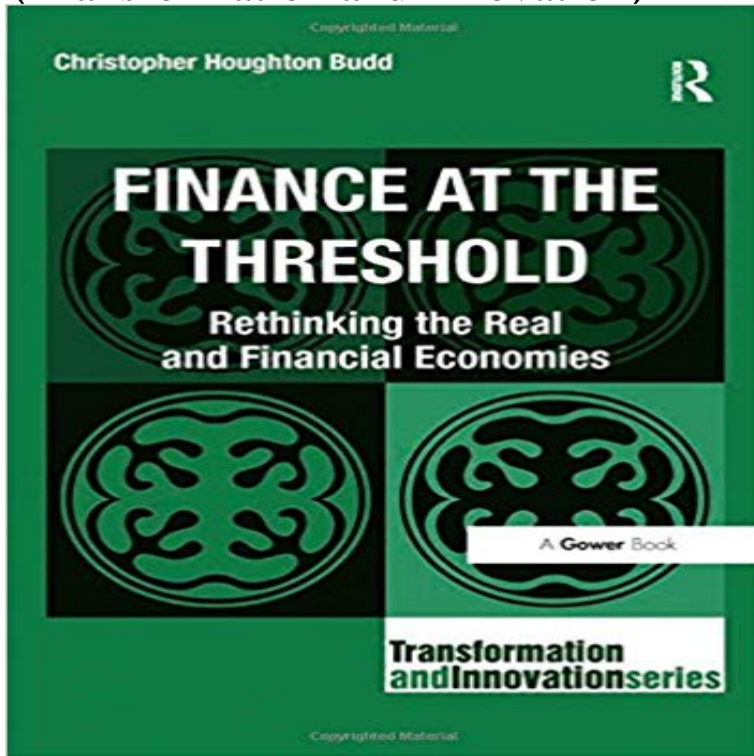


# Finance at the Threshold: Rethinking the Real and Financial Economies (Transformation and Innovation)
