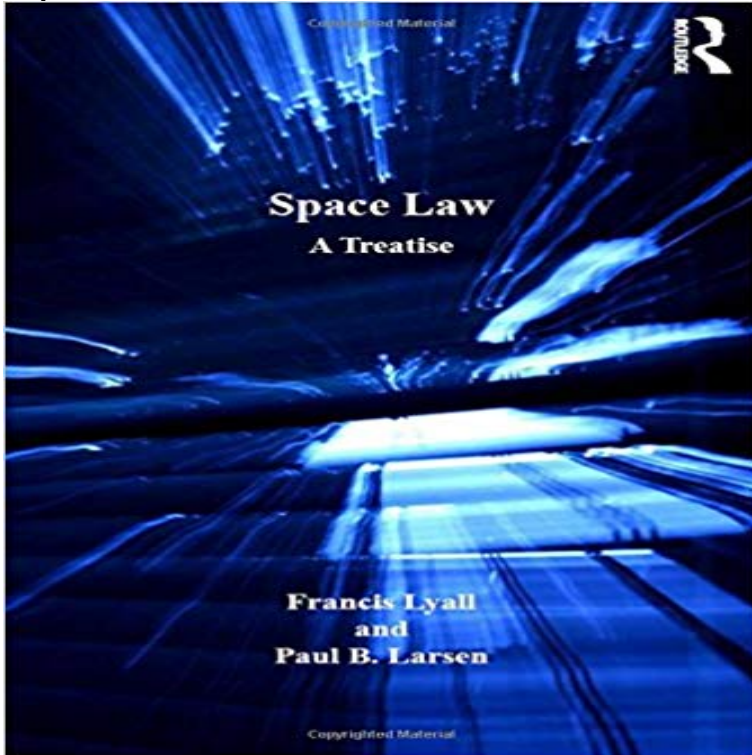


Space Law: A Treatise
