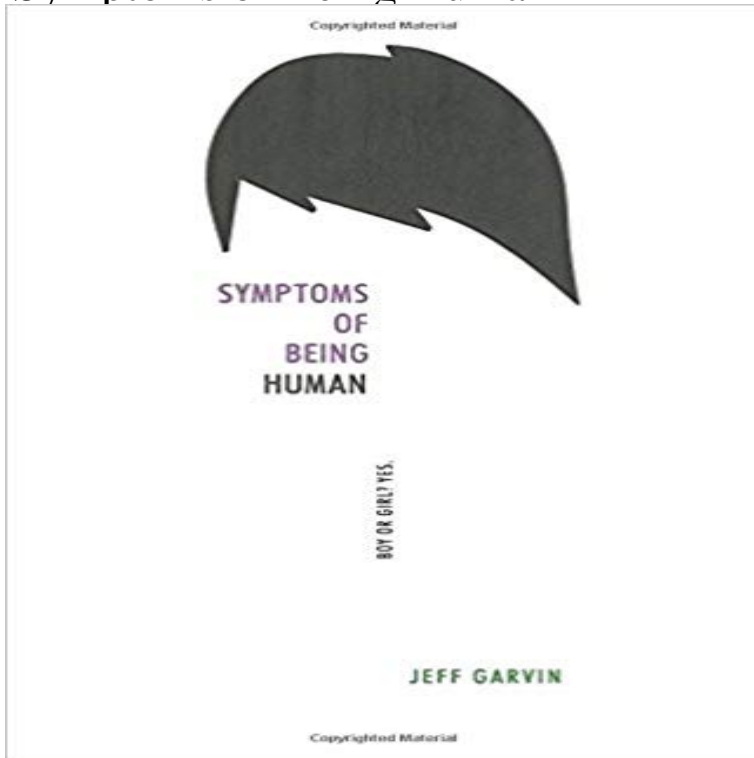


Symptoms of Being Human
