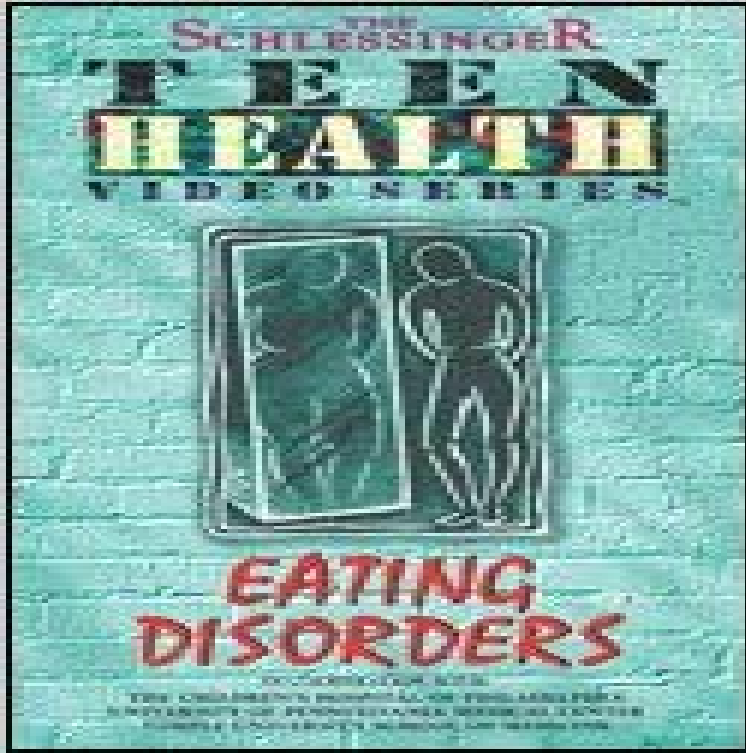


Teen Health Eating Disorders Schlessinger



In this program, compelling interviews with several teens who have suffered from compulsive over-eating, anorexia nervosa, and bulimia provide a living portrait of eating disorders. Young women and, to a lesser extent, young men succumb to these eating disorders as a way to gain control over their bodies, and consequently, their lives. Becoming isolated and secretive, victims of these disorders often deny their illness and impede attempts at treatment. Experts in the field discuss the causes and symptoms of eating disorders, techniques for prevention and detection, and the treatments available. Discussions are led by adolescent medicine specialists. Dynamic graphics and music help present the information in a memorable and non-judgmental way.
