

The research draws upon a number of sources, including medieval Welsh tales, the archaeology of Stonehenges Salisbury Plain, the legends surrounding the founding of Britain, the cult of the Thracian Horseman, the oracle of Dodona, popular Arthurian mythology, and the basic principles of prehistoric astronomy.
