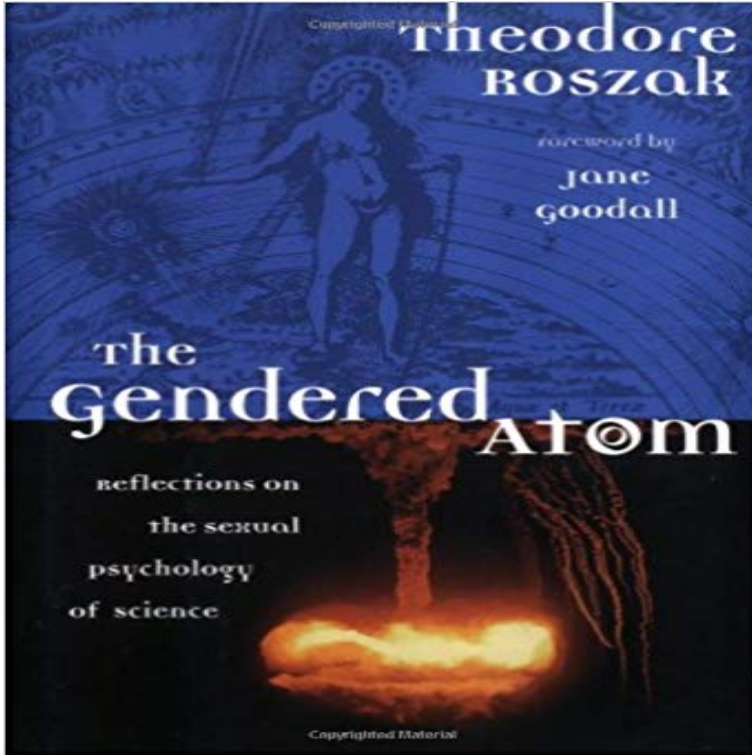


# The Gendered Atom: Reflections on the Sexual Psychology of Science
