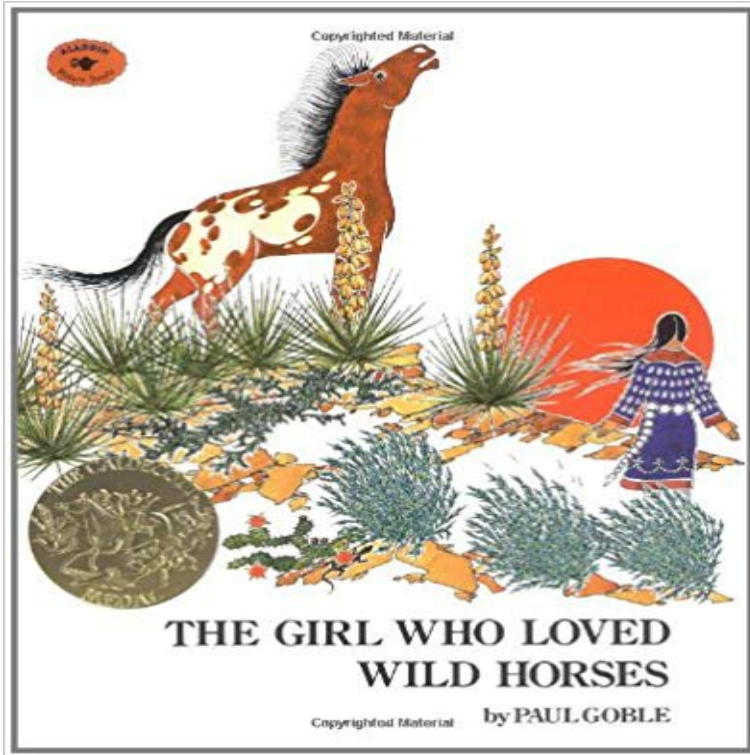


The Girl Who Loved Wild Horses
