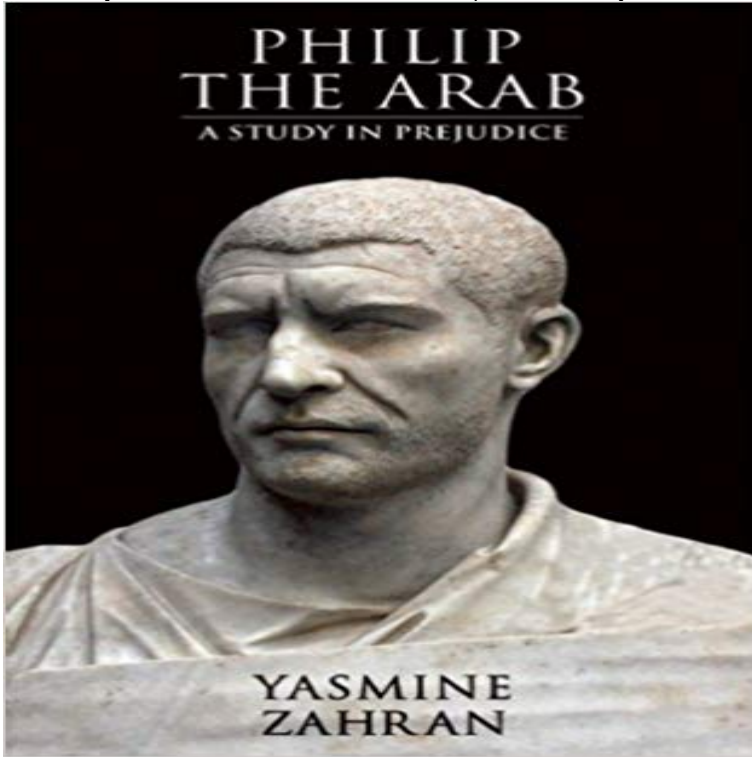


# Philip the Arab: A Study in Prejudice
