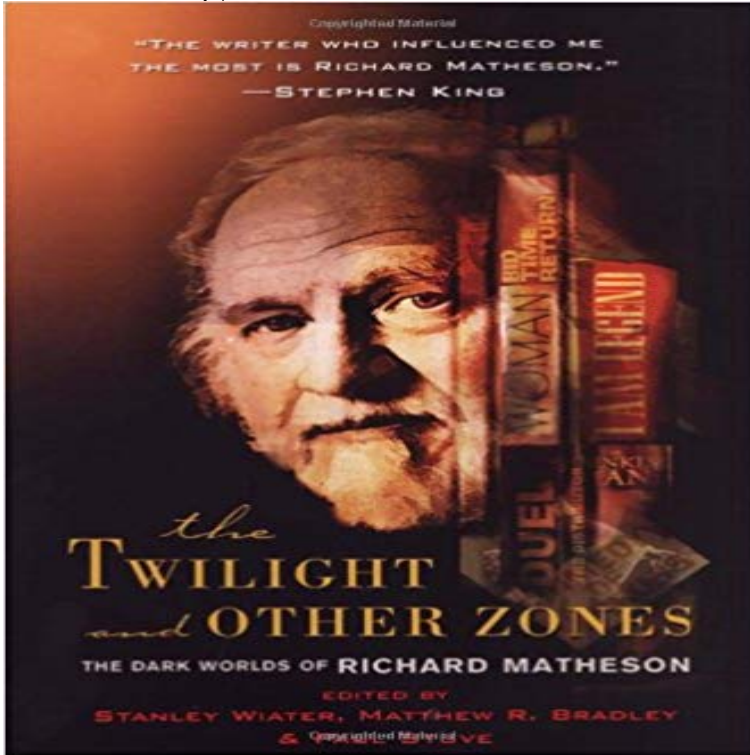

Bradley holds a B.A. in English Literature from Trinity College and worked in the book publishing and home video industries for 20 years. Currently he is copy specialist for MBI, Inc., in Norwalk, Connecticut, where he lives with his wife and daughter. Paul Stuve is a clinical psychologist when he is not reading, collecting, or, most recently, writing about Richard Matheson.
